

General Waste

Items going in the bag:

- cooked food waste, cold frying fat and bones
- hygienic paper, nappies and sanitary napkins
- wallpaper, wallpaper offcuts
- vacuum cleaner bags, sweepings, ashes
- cigarette stubs, cable offcuts, light bulbs
- cat litter, wood shavings, wood offcuts
- china, ceramics, stoneware
- household articles such as pots, bowls and buckets
- utility items such as bags, toys, cassettes and ball pens
- silo cover offcuts and bale straps
- extremely soiled paper and packaging
- floor-covering offcuts and polystyrene ceiling tiles

Items not going in the bag:

- hazardous waste such as
- batteries
 - paint/lacquer
 - oil filters, oily fabric
 - household chemical waste
 - energy-saving lamps and
 - paper, cardboard
 - compostable green waste
 - electrical appliances, electronic children's toys
 - packaging made of glass, plastic, metal or laminated packaging

Important information!

The bags mustn't weigh more than 15 kg. Small electrical appliances such as electrical toothbrushes, hairdryers, egg cookers, shavers, blenders can be dropped off at local electronics stores. For more information please call our toll-free hotline: 0800 – 9 25 24 23.

Waste Paper

Items going in the bag:

- newspapers, magazines
- prospectuses, brochures
- catalogues, telephone directories
- notebooks, books
- writing paper, copy and computer paper
- letters, envelopes
- cardboard, cardboard boxes
- wrapping paper, paper bags
- clean packaging made of paper/cardboard as well as clean cardboard boxes, e.g. sugar or flour bags, biscuit or pizza cartons

Items not going in the bag:

- wallpaper and wallpaper offcuts
- hygienic paper: used paper handkerchiefs, paper towels and napkins, nappies, sanitary napkins
- soiled paper
- parchment and sandwich paper
- laminated paper, such as deep-freeze packaging, single-use cardboard dishes, etc.
- beverage and milk cartons
- photos

Important information!

The bags mustn't weigh more than 15 kg. The blue plastic bags may be used for waste paper only.

Packaging Waste

Plastic, laminate and metal packaging.

Items going in the bag:

- dairy product and margarine containers
- fruit, vegetable and salad containers
- detergent and cosmetics containers
- plastic bottles
- plastic bags, freezer bags and plastic film
- sweet, noodle, rice bags, etc.
- fruit, vegetable and potato mesh bags
- (beverage) cans
- aluminium cans, foil, and containers
- empty, CFC-free spray cans used for whipped cream, hair spray, etc.
- beverage and milk cartons
- vacuum packaging used for coffee etc.
- deep-freeze packaging

Items not going in the bag:

- household articles made of plastic or metal, such as pots, frying pans, bowls, buckets, etc.
- nappies and sanitary napkins
- children's toys
- floor or ceiling coverings, cable offcuts
- small electrical appliances such as hairdryers, shavers, etc.
- CDs, DVDs, video tapes or cassettes
- silo covers, bale straps, mesh wraps from hay bales
- contaminated packaging or packaging with hazardous content (e.g. spray paint cans)
- extremely soiled or partly-filled packaging

Important information!

Please see that only empty containers or packaging are put in the yellow bag. Packaging needn't be washed out before disposed of. Yellow bags can be obtained freely from local retailers, the municipal administration or municipality as well as your local waste management service provider.

Biodegradable Waste

Items going in the bag:

- tree and shrub clippings
- hedge clippings
- grass, weeds
- leaves, moss
- windfalls
- withered flowers and plants
- indoor plants
- raw kitchen waste, such as vegetable and potato peelings
- raw fruit waste
- tea bags and coffee filters

Items not going in the bag:

- cooked food waste
- bones, bread
- frying fat
- household and street sweepings
- ashes
- pet litter, wood shavings, wood wool
- hygienic paper
- paper handkerchiefs
- nappies, sanitary napkins
- flower pots
- glass, metal, plastics

Important information!

The bags mustn't weigh more than 15 kg. Garden waste serves as feedstock for the production of valuable hygienic and weed-seed free compost, which can be reused in the garden. Waste Glass

Container glass includes the following:

- one-way beverage, vinegar or oil bottles, etc.
- preserving or other food jars used for jam, vegetables, fruit, mustard, etc.
- drinking glasses
- transparent cosmetic jars

Clear glass goes in the white glass bank.

Green glass goes in the green bank.

Brown glass goes in the brown bank.

Glass of any other colour, e.g. blue, goes in the green bank.

The following items don't belong in waste glass banks:

- light bulbs
- fluorescent tubes and energy-saving lamps
- window glass, auto glass
- picture frame glass, mirrors
- china, ceramics, stoneware
- heat resistant glassware, such as ovenproof dishes, etc.
- optical glass, e.g. eyeglasses
- caps or bottle tops of any kind

Important information!

According to prevailing waste disposal statutes, dumping glass such as window glass, auto glass, etc. is an offence punishable by a fine.

Bulky Refuse and Electrical Appliances

include the following:

items that can't be put in waste bags because they are bulky, too heavy or mustn't be put there due to their consistency:

- chairs, stools, tables
- wardrobes, cupboards, shelves, chests of drawers
- armchairs, sofas, couches
- beds, mattresses, bedframes
- bicycles, children's pushchairs, children's car seats
- carpets, floor coverings, (bundled) toe boards
- kitchen sinks, ovens
- washing machines, tumble dryers, dishwashers, electric cookers
- fridges, deep freezers
- vacuum cleaners, floor lamps, auxiliary heating devices
- TV sets, radios, Hi-Fi equipment
- electric lawn mowers

Bulky waste does not include:

- refurbishment waste such as building rubble, doors, windows, wood, bricks, sanitary ceramics, radiators, etc.
- used tyres, car batteries, car parts
- wire netting and barbed wire, garden fences, silo covers
- general waste and recyclable waste, bags and cardboard (boxes)
- small items that can also be put in general waste bags
- hazardous waste, such as paint, oil containers, oil tanks, night-storage heaters, etc.
- old clothes
- waste from companies or facilities using ALL Container-Service GmbH waste containers

Important information!
